### **A New Standard for Sustainable Living**

The Pangea Community is built on the principles of off-grid living, combining renewable energy, regenerative farming, and eco-conscious design. Highlights of the development include:

- **Affordable Housing:** Homes for families, essential workers, and seniors that eliminate utility costs through off-grid systems.
- **Sustainable Infrastructure:** Solar, wind, and micro-hydro energy; rainwater harvesting; greywater recycling, blackwater botanical cells, passive solar, thermal dynamics, recycled materials and more.
- **Regenerative Food Systems:** Earthship Walipinis, organic farms, and permaculture practices to produce fresh food year-round for all people of Taos, New Mexico.
- **Cultural Collaboration:** A Community Arts & Cultural Center that can serve as a cultural embassy for the people of Taos, fostering cultural exchange, and supporting revenue-sharing initiatives that support affordable housing and food sovereignty in Taos, New Mexico.

### **Honoring Taos' Unique Legacy**

This development is more than a housing project—it's a celebration of Taos' resilience, culture, and deep connection to the land. The community's design and amenities reflect its commitment to preserving the rural character of Taos while promoting sustainability and multigenerational living. Potential collaborations with local artisans, Institutions, Museums and others ensure this project is a collaboration rooted in the heart of Taos.
